## Technical Notice: FTP.morningstar.com DR Failover Test

On April 6<sup>th</sup>, we will conduct the annual DR failover test for our FTP.morningstar.com service, confirming the readiness and effectiveness of its disaster recovery plan and ensuring Morningstar's capability to seamlessly transition to backup systems if necessary.

### On the day:

- 8 AM CDT: We will perform failover and initial tests, which will last less than an hour. A 20-minute outage is expected during this period.
- 9 AM CDT: FTP.morningstar.com live traffic will be run from its secondary site and be available for testing.
- 2 PM CDT: We will switch back to the primary site, with a second 20-minute outage.
- Failback might be delayed if testers require additional time.

### Participation:

We recommend participating in the test on April 6<sup>th</sup>, verifying all systems within your purview that utilize FTP.morningstar.com. This ensures comprehensive end-to-end testing, fostering confidence that any potential service interruption will be minimized in the event of an actual failover requirement.

### Preparation:

We have found that most failures during a failover test are the result of incomplete outbound firewall rules or connections being made directly to an IP address. Both causes, if left unaddressed, could result in a five-hour outage during this test as the primary site will be down. We will be unable to reactivate it before 2 PM. To avoid this, please:

- Validate all connections are to the FTP.morningstar.com URL only. Please never target an individual IP address.
- Validate all firewall rules or access lists are complete and detail both IP addresses shown below.

Our secondary FTP site is only accessible when live. Testing in advance is not possible.

Attempts to access the secondary site outside of this test window will result in a connection error. This is expected behavior.
